As part of our partnership with the National Outreach Programme, we will be running a careers trip to the University of Birmingham. This is a follow up to their University visit last year but this time giving the students an experience of a 'Russell Group University'. The Russell University Group signals the top 25 Universities in Britain, of which The University of Birmingham is one.

The outreach programme is delivered by Aimhigher Plus; a partnership of regional universities and colleges, and is being coordinated locally by Herefordshire and Ludlow College and Hereford College of Arts.

The aim of the trip is to support students' aspirations and some of the options available to them post Kingstone High School. This trip is unique to Kingstone High School, meaning that we will be the only school attending on the day.
